

CHANDLER EDUCATION FOUNDATION BENEFIT RAFFLE 2007-2008 RULES

1. Grand Prize will be a 2008 BMW, Z4 Coupe/Roadster. Valued at approximately \$40,000. No cash award will be given for the grand prize.
2. The purchase of a Raffle certificate is \$20.00. If an entrant pays by check, the seller will write the certificate number/numbers on that check. If an entrant would like to pay by credit card at a school function and/or the mall, a credit card slip will be manually filled out with the credit card number, purchaser's name, address and telephone number along with the Raffle certificate number(s). Additionally, he or she may contact the Foundation office at (480) 812-7633 to purchase the Raffle certificates. If a check or credit card is dishonored by the bank, the Raffle certificate will be declared invalid unless full payment is made prior to the drawing. Any dishonored check or credit card will be considered an invalid entry and the entrant will be notified by telephone or mail.
3. Raffle certificates may be purchased via the internet through the Chandler Education Foundation (CEF) website at www.ChandlerEdFoundation.org. A link is also available at www.winthebmw.com. The purchaser will automatically receive a confirmation of the raffle certificate purchase/donation. **If a confirmation is not received, your purchase/donation was not received by the CEF office.** Upon receipt of the purchase/donation, the CEF staff member will fill out the purchaser's name, address and phone number on the raffle certificate stub. The stub will be placed in the bin with all other "sold" raffle certificates and the remainder of the ticket will be sent to the ticket purchaser.
4. Completed Raffle certificate may be delivered to and must be in the possession of the Chandler Education Foundation representative (1525 West Frye Road, Chandler, Arizona 85224) by 3:00 PM on February 13, 2008, to be eligible for the Chandler Education Foundation 2007/2008 BMW Raffle.
5. Sellers and purchasers of Raffle certificates must be 21 years of age or older.
6. Chandler Education Foundation Board members, CEF office personnel and their family members living in the same household are ineligible to participate.
7. Name of the winner will be available to the media and all raffle participants, displayed on the Chandler Education Foundation website (www.chandleredfoundation.org) and at the Foundation office located at 1525 West Frye Road, Chandler, Arizona 85224.
8. A maximum of 25,000 Raffle certificates will be sold. The Raffle will be closed at approximately 7:15 PM on February 13, 2008, or when 25,000 sold Raffle certificate forms are in possession of the Chandler

Education Foundation, Inc. or its representatives, whichever occurs first. However, Raffle certificates will be available for sale to those who attend the Chandler Education Foundation Auction event on February 13, 2008, until the final call for ticket sales is announced at the event at which time Raffle certificate sales will end to everyone. Any Raffle certificate forms and money turned in after the closure of the Raffle will be returned to the buyer. All Raffle certificate forms will be recorded on a first come, first served basis.

9. In the event 25,000 certificates are sold, each certificate has a 1-in-25,000 chance to win the 2008 BMW.
10. Winner will be determined by a random drawing, the drawing date will be February 13, 2008, at the Chandler Education Foundation Auction event. The location is yet to be determined and will be disclosed at a later date. The public is invited to attend. The prize will be released after February 23, 2008. Any disputed claim must be presented before that date.
11. Winners will assume responsibility for all licensing, registration, transport, and all other fees, and local, state and federal taxes, including without limitation all applicable sales, use, luxury, income and special taxes. **THE CHANDLER EDUCATION FOUNDATION SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ALL EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE REGARDING THE 2008 BMW Z4.**
12. If at least 2,000 Raffle certificates are not sold, by February 1, 2008, the Chandler Education Foundation at its option, may cancel the Raffle and shall return in full to each participant the purchase price of the Raffle certificate.
13. More than one name **MAY NOT** be stated on the Raffle certificate. Payment or delivery of any prize shall be made solely to the entrant. The Social Security number of the winner must be provided.
14. The decision of Chandler Education Foundation, Inc. shall be final on all matters concerning the Raffle.
15. Void where prohibited by law.
16. The purchase of the BMW Z4 will be through Chapman BMW, 6601 East McDowell Road, Scottsdale, Arizona 85257.
17. The raffle will be officiated by: Law offices of D. Marlane Porter.
18. For this raffle it is understood and agreed that Arizona laws apply.
19. Please note that the IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances to participate in a raffle do not qualify as a tax deductible charitable contribution.
20. Winner is required to claim the vehicle within six (6) months of the Final Draw date.

21. Initial entry purchaser must be present in the state of Arizona at the time of purchase. It is not necessary to be a resident of the State of Arizona, but one must be physically present in Arizona at the time of entry purchase. A hard copy ticket confirmation number is required to claim a prize with appropriate ID.

22. Waiver / Limitations of Liability

Raffle certificate purchasers, by participating (and winners, by accepting a prize) release the Chandler Education Foundation and Chandler Education Foundation Board of Directors, Chandler Unified School District and their respective parent companies, affiliates, partners, subsidiaries, agents, representatives, sponsors, service agencies and independent contractors, and each of their respective directors, officers, partners, employees and agents, including advertising and promotion agencies, from any and all liability with respect to participation in the promotion, possession, use and distribution of the prize awarded.

23. Taxes and IRS Rules

All winners shall be responsible for any and all federal, state and local income or excise taxes, fees, assessments and like charges associated with the prizes. The vehicle winner shall be responsible for any and all state or local license, title and registration fees associated with the vehicle.
