

What is Chandler Education Foundation?

Established 36 years ago,
Chandler Education Foundation is the original non-profit fundraiser
for Chandler Unified School District.



The Foundation exists to invest community support into educational opportunities, paving the way to lifelong success for CUSD students.

By utilizing private investment in public education, the Foundation seeks to maximize growth as students become engaged members of a global community.

There are three staff members and 18 volunteer board members who support the Foundation.

In addition to the IMPACT program, Chandler Education Foundation supports teacher scholarships for advanced degrees and certifications, classroom enrichment grants, over \$100,000 in donor scholarships, and supports the district's crisis funds.



What is IMPACT?

IMPACT is a *recognition* program offered through Chandler Education Foundation with opportunities to apply for scholarship funding once qualifications are met.



Students who enroll in the ICS program commit to:

- **3.4 or higher <u>cumulative</u> GPA** (assessed at the end of senior year)
- 95% or greater cumulative attendance
- Completion of 100 hours of qualified community service.
- o Hours must be submitted through Infinite Campus and approved by CEF.
- Hours performed for the benefit of a religious organization are not eligible.
 Ex: Altar service, home visits for members, childcare, bible school/camp
 Service may be counted if an organization is performing an activity for the benefit of the greater community. Ex: food, clothing, or supply drive.



What/How

IMPACT is a recognition program offered through Chandler Education Foundation with opportunities to apply for scholarship funding once qualifications are met.



Students who enroll in the ICS program commit to:


- 3.4 or higher <u>cumulative</u> GPA (assessed at the end of senior year)
- o 95% or greater cumulative attendance
- Completion of 100 hours of qualified community service.
 - Hours must be submitted through Infinite Campus and approved by CEF.
 - Hours performed for the benefit of a religious organization are not eligible.

Examples of not eligible hours: Altar service, home visits for members, childcare, bible school/camp, babysitting for family members, and assisting with family needs. Parents may not supervise hours.

Service may be counted if an organization is performing an activity for the benefit of the greater community. Ex: food, clothing, or supply drive.



Opt-In During Freshman year






Step 2: Select [More] on the bottom left of the screen.

Step 3: Select [Impact Chandler Scholars] on the next menu.

Step 4: Complete Form/Sign/Print/Submit.

Step 5: Check school email for confirmation.









Submit Hours

- Use the SAME link used to opt into IMPACT in Infinite Campus.
- Submit once for multiple dates of service at the same location.
- Check within 2 weeks to confirm hours were approved.
- Eligible hours from 1st day of freshman year.

Please remember:

- . 100 hours of community service must be submitted to Infinite Campus by April 1st of your senior year. No exceptions will be made.
- Service through a religious organization must benefit the broader community and typically be performed outside the organization's grounds. It
 may not involve religious teaching or instruction.

MPORTANT: This program uses the student's school Google email account, S179436@gse.cusd80.com , for all communications.

Please combine multiple entries for the same service (ex: volunteering at the library each Wednesday for 10 weeks should be combined into one entry).

NOTE: Feed My Starving Children must be submitted as single sessions only. Check for messages under the ICS tab in Infinite Campus to confirm your entry was received and credited (typically within 72 hours).

How to Qualify to Apply for Scholarships:

Students are responsible to review IMPACT information listed on the CEF website ChandlerEducationFoundation.org and to verify information on Infinite Campus under their ICS tab is accurate:



- o GPA
- Attendance
- Submitted/Approved/Denied Hours

Applications open for scholarships open in late December for eligible seniors. Visit the Foundation's IMPACT page for additional information and links to the online application. A one-page essay is required.

Essays are scored by a panel of volunteers, and content and conventions are evaluated.
